STEAMBOAT DANCE THEATRE'S 2018 PROGRAMMATIC ACHIEVEMENTS



ANNUAL CONCERT

This year's concert theme was: "A Moment in Time".

The concert featured 15 pieces (one of which was choreographed by one of our scholarship students) and 130 dancers. The concert attracted 2000 audience members over 4 performances.

DANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1st Position Scholarships are awarded to local community members of all ages with financial need wanting to attend local dance classes. 5th Position Scholarships are awarded to dancers of all ages with financial need planning to participate in competitions or more advanced dance workshops in other cities or states.
- In Fiscal Year 2018, SDT awarded 157 1st Position Scholarships and 14 5th Position Scholarship, totaling of \$16,183 in scholarships given.
- Of the total number of scholarships given, 80% of the recipients' household incomes were below the median income of \$63,505 in Routt County.
- Of the total number of scholarships given, 40% were provided to households with incomes of \$40,000 or less and household sizes ranging from 2-6 people.
- Scholarship students choreographed and performed in a piece in the Annual Concert.

11 Years Old Master Ballet Academy in Scottsdale, AZ

This summer Soleil received a 5th Position Scholarship which allowed her to attend the Master Ballet Academy. Only 90 students are accepted nationwide and Soleil was one of them. Students from the Master Ballet Academy are often in the top 3 at Nationals every year at the Grand Prix and they also have many students who are now competing at the International Ballet Competition. Soleil has also been given the opportunity to have a contemporary solo created by the renowned Rasta Thomas, who has won many of these competitions.

MAILE BUSCHMANN

10 Years Old School of American Ballet, New York, New York

This summer Maile received a 5th Position Scholarship which allowed her to attend a brand new program at the School of American Ballet's (SAB) headquarters in Manhattan. Maile took classes with SAB's permanent faculty and guest teachers including principal dancers from New York City Ballet. In addition to daily technique and variations classes, the program offers cultural enrichment seminars to further broaden young minds' exposure to the arts.

 Co-hosted 5 free Dance on Film events, which featured the following films:


